Bring your childhood videotapes to life

Rooms of Our Childhood is a performative installation looking for people, who want to submit their childhood VHS tapes from the '90s.

Rooms of Our Childhood is a multimedia installation that explores the memories and experiences of people from different countries, cultures, and backgrounds who have grown up during the same period of time, from 1993 to 1999 and who live now in France. The installation builds upon my previous work, The Room of Our Childhood, which premiered at [ThessFringe](#).

The installation will consist of a web of rooms. 4 walls of each room will be turned into 4 projection screens, showcasing personal videos from participants from around the world. The videos will be edited and curated to create a seamless flow of images that evoke the essence of childhood and the unique experiences of each participant. The project aims to investigate how similar or different childhoods can be for people born in different parts of the world and who happen to call France their home. By juxtaposing multiple childhoods from different backgrounds and experiences, the installation creates a space for reflection and dialogue about the shared experiences and unique differences in our lives.

The premiere of ROOMS will take place at Microcredit (Paris).

This is a paid opportunity starting with 50 EUROS and goes up depending on the size of the contribution.
