Projects should aim to inspire Europeans to reengage with their democracies in a hopeful and constructive manner.

Application Details:

Proposals must be submitted in English and include a complete budget. Eligible applicants include civic, public, or private organizations with legal status operating in various societal

sectors. Applications from political parties will not be accepted. A diverse and realistic budget, along with innovative approaches, will be evaluated.
