

Greece Türkiye Residencies Open Call Cultural Synergies Curatorial Residency Exchange Between Greece and Türkiye





ARTWORKS and SAHA are launching a collaborative Curatorial Residency Exchange Program, offering curators an opportunity to engage in the art ecosystem of a different country. Over a six-week residency, participants will meet with local artists, institutions, and curatorial practices, fostering crosscultural dialogue.

About the Residency

The Curatorial Residency Exchange Program is designed for curators seeking to broaden their professional horizons and gain deep insights into another country's cultural landscape. The program will support two selected curators:

Athens Residency: One curator from Türkiye will be hosted in Athens for six weeks (May–June 2025). Istanbul Residency: One curator from Greece will spend six weeks in Istanbul (September–October 2025).





During their stay, participants will have the opportunity to conduct research, network with local art professionals, and present their curatorial perspectives in a new cultural environment.

Residency Benefits

- Accommodation & Travel Support: Fully covered expenses for accommodation and travel.

- Living Stipend: A financial allowance to cover daily expenses during the residency.

- Professional Networking: Access to artists, curators,

institutions, and cultural practitioners through studio visits, discussions, and events.

- Cultural Immersion: Exclusive visits to museums, archives, and contemporary art spaces.

- Mentorship & Institutional Support: Guidance from ARTWORKS and SAHA, along with experienced professionals from the host country's art scene.

Eligibility & Application Requirements

Open to curators based in Greece and Türkiye with a minimum of 7 years of professional experience in contemporary art.

To apply, candidates must submit the following materials as a single PDF file:

Curatorial Statement (500 words max.): Describe your curatorial practice, past experiences, and reasons for applying.
Curriculum Vitae (CV): Provide an overview of your education, professional background, and key projects.

- Portfolio: Documentation of curatorial projects (e.g., exhibitions, essays, publications).
