The <u>Design Academy NOVA</u> offers designers access to rare, innovative, and sustainable materials, ranging from bio-based and cellulose-based to recycled and advanced technological textiles. It combines remote learning, mentorship, and an inperson design sprint residency in Berlin, culminating in a public showcase during Berlin Fashion Week 2026.

The programme is designed to push creative boundaries and





foster industry-wide transformation by combining creativity, sustainability, and material science. Participants will join a pan-European community of peers, mentors, and potential collaborators.

Eligibility

- Open to freelance designers and designers from brands based in Europe
- Applications accepted between April 7 and May 12, 2025
- Designers must be prepared to participate remotely and partially in-person
- All sessions and training conducted in English
