Following its first edition in Florence in 2024, which gathered over 1,300 participants, the festival now heads to Zagreb for three days of discussions, interactive workshops, exhibitions, and networking opportunities.

- Disinformation and elections' integrity
- Journalistic safety and press freedom
- Challenges in media economic models
- Media literacy and digital well-being
