## Upcoming Open Call Highlights

After a highly successful pilot edition of Perform Europe, Perform Europe announced a new Open Call for partnership projects. The call launches on 1 December 2023 and stays open until 31 March 2024. It's aimed at supporting innovative models for inclusion and greening in the performing arts. The 2.1 million EURO fund will be allocated to at least 35 successful partnership proposals, with a maximum grant of 60.000 EURO for each selected project. All organisations and professionals working in the performing arts, and legally based in one of the 40 Creative Europe Countries, are eligible to apply. Applications by or involving underrepresented areas or groups are particularly welcomed. Full information about the open call will be revealed during the Open Call Launch Event, but in the meantime, you can refer to Perform Europe website to find out more.
