On May 14, 2025, from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM (CET), the Faculty of Arts at KU Leuven will host a lecture by cultural theorist Professor Justin O'Connor, titled Culture is not an Industry: 1 Year On. The event will take place in the Justus Lipsiuszaal, Erasmushuis, and will also be accessible online.

In his lecture, Professor O'Connor will revisit the core arguments of his influential book Culture is not an Industry: Reclaiming art and culture for the common good (2024). He will critically examine the impact of the creative industries paradigm and advocate for a renewed understanding of culture as a vital public good.
