Open Call for Artists

Moving Balkans is looking for existing choreographic works addressing the social, artistic and environmental issues of our time.

The executive producers of the submitted work should be based and reside in the following countries: Albania, Bosnia and





Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, and Türkiye.

Selected works will be presented during the 1st edition of the Moving Balkans - Contemporary Dance Showcase, held in Ljubljana (Slovenia), Rijeka (Croatia) and Zagreb (Croatia) between 10 and 13 May 2025.

The selected performances will tour the three cities, performing for the general public and the international community of contemporary dance professionals. Furthermore, the works will benefit from the network touring scheme.
