About Creative Europe

[Creative Europe](#) is the European Union programme for the cultural and creative sectors. Under the Culture sub-programme, the scheme offers financial support through grants for networks, platforms, and cooperation projects.

The focus of this course will be the "European cooperation projects" funding line, which supports large, medium and small-scale initiatives piloted by organisations in the EU and beyond. The aim of the programme is to support access to arts and culture and foster innovation and creativity at a European level.

Who is it for?

- Performing arts organisations and non-profit organisations focusing on arts education that would like to know more about Creative Europe [cooperation projects](#), with the aim of applying for funding in early 2024.

Outcomes for participants

- Knowledge of the Creative Europe programme and
