- Industrial heritage

Digitalisation is one of the biggest challenges of the near future? What opportunities do we see for culture and what threats are there? How do we involve young people in projects whose approach to information and culture is shaped by digital media?

- Sustainability

How can cultural centres and work help tackle the climate crisis? What ideas and successful examples are there?

- Diversity

Global crises are leading to ever greater migration movements. Europe is becoming a continent of immigration. Our societies are becoming more and more diverse in every conceivable way. How do we deal with these changes, what influence does this have on our daily work?
